What are AI tools?

- Most AI tools are made up of three components:
 - o Data resource
 - What is the source of information the AI tools will get data from?
 - o Contextual Language Model
 - "Chatting" with the data resource
 - Sense of Self Learning
 - RAGs Retrieval-Augmented Generation
 - Fine-Tuning

What should we expect from them?

- Very often these tools are oversold in their capability and aren't quite at the stage of total dependence on them.
 - But that doesn't mean we should ignore them altogether instead we can utilize elements of what each tool can do.
- Treat AI tools as assistants that do about 70% of the work, but we still need to polish the final product.

How can we use them?

- Al tools work great as communication tools especially as so many people are used to conversational formats that can provide us with information.
- Explore some various business AI tools and see how they could be utilised in a way that bridges the gap between Rock admins, pastors and even church members.
